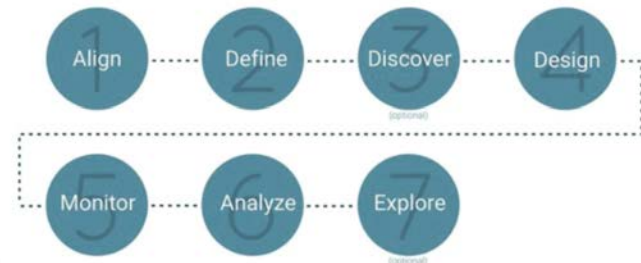
Easy ZOOM In.....

Out of the dozens of different learning evaluation models currently in practice, which one is right for you? Turns out, you don't have to limit yourself to just one!

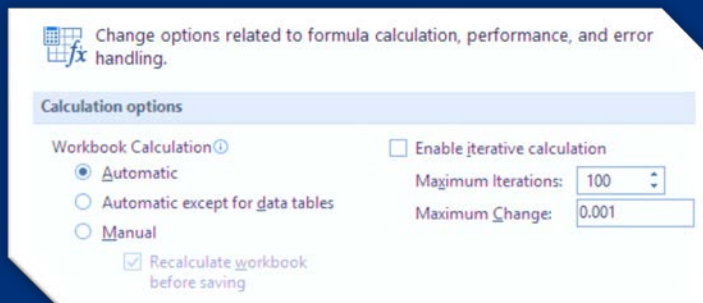
Seven Steps of Learning Evaluation



EXCEL TIP - The formula is not calculating!

When a formula does not calculate, you have to check if automatic calculation is enabled in Excel. Formulas will not calculate if manual calculation is enabled. Follow these steps to check for **Automatic calculation**:

1. Click the **File** tab, click **Options**, and then click the **Formulas** category.
2. In the **Calculation options** section, under **Workbook Calculation**, make sure the **Automatic** option is selected.
