Have you ever googled something and gotten results you have to filter through going back decades? Well, Google has announced a new search bar command that enables users to filter results for a desired date range. The “before:YYYY-MM-DD” and “after:YYYY-MM-DD” shortcuts yield results for before, after, and within the dates specified.

To get results after a given date, add “after:YYYY-MM-DD” at the end of your search. For example, searching “top 10 movies after:2018-12-31” will provide you with results that were published in 2019 and onward!
